Reclaimed Building Materials at Home in Ft. Collins

May 17th, 2006 – 1501 North College Avenue, Ft. Collins, Colorado is the official address for Colorado's newest ReSource outlet. ReSource, a non-profit organization that salvages and re-sells used building materials, opened its doors at its new permanent location on Wednesday May 17th and is now open for business 5 days a week (Tuesday through Friday 10am – 6pm and Saturdays 9am – 5pm).

Open for business means accepting materials from the public, including individuals, construction companies and new building material businesses, and selling those materials back to the public at at least 50% below retail.

Visit ReSource on any given day and you'll find a variety of people milling around among the racks; artists looking for glass or metal, do-it-yourself homeowners hunting for oak flooring or contractors collecting framing lumber. All of these people have two things in common: they'd rather see these materials re-used than in a landfill, and they appreciate a bargain.

In addition to selling building materials, ReSource also produces a line of furniture made from, you guessed it, salvaged materials. The ReSource Woodworks line features Adirondack chairs from redwood decking, coffee tables from bamboo wood flooring, and mirrors framed with pine, cherry, oak, and old window sashes.

ReSource accepts materials on a donation basis and, because it has 501c3 status, can provide a tax deduction in exchange. Pick-ups and deliveries of materials are available. Call 970-498-9663 (wood) for information about hours, location, acceptable materials, and current inventory.

ReSource has been open in Boulder for 10 years and is managed by The Center for ReSource Conservation, a non-profit organization established in Boulder in 1976.
